RULES AND REGULATIONS

Applicants for scholarship will be selected from high school graduates who are about to enter an accredited institution of higher learning or who are already enrolled in an accredited institution.

1. Scholarship shall be awarded primarily on the basis of scholastic achievement. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 is required. Financial need shall not be considered unless all other qualifications are considered equal.
2. The applicant must produce evidence of scholarly achievement (i.e., most recent school transcripts and other supportive evidence, such as SAT scores) in order to receive scholarship consideration. College students need only supply college transcripts only.
3. All applicants for scholarship award shall be required to complete Personal History form, also Scholastic history, to be certified by their High School, College, University, or Institution.
4. All applications for Scholarship grants must be filed with the Scholarship Committee by **May 07, 2010**.
5. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
6. The award shall be distributed on the basis of a deserving gift, with no financial obligation on the part of the recipient.
7. The award shall be made payable to the applicant upon approval by the Scholarship Committee.
